services delivered by and through Go-Woman! Alliance.

allow all staff /volunteers to make informed and confident responses to specific child protection issues

GOAL ethos is to work closely with all childcare professional/provision (with parental consent or without if unable to obtain

parental consent if after discussions with Designated Safeguarding lead a child is deemed to be at risk of harm) to ensure best possible

outcomes for all children.
