## Preparation for Work - Package of support

Go-Woman! Alliance Community Interest Company (GOAL) secured funding through Heart of England Community Foundation - ESF Community Grants.

ESF Community Grants are intended for unemployed and economically inactive people who face barriers to employment through non-accredited learning.

'At GOAL we have been supporting individuals to develop their cv's but felt that this in no way made them work ready. *Preparation for Work* programme was specifically developed to ensure that there was a comprehensive package of support available to these individuals.

Each participant will be assigned a mentor who will work with them to develop a portfolio, preparing individuals for the job market.

The programme will consist of two weeks compulsory work experience, allowing individuals to put their learning into practice and on successful completion gaining a nationally recognised qualification through Open College Network West Midlands Region titled 'Preparation for Work - Level 1 Award'.

This programme will make a real difference to individuals', said Yasmin Akhtar, project manager at the group.
