GOAL's Grundtvig project will be focusing on Internet Technology for disadvantage people. The project will involve partners from Austria, Turkey and UK.

Leonardo programmes allows organisations, staff and learners to work together with European partners to improve training, skills and employability. GOAL's Leonardo project will look at Development of Skills Training ran in Enterprises in Turkey, Spain and the UK.

Yasmin Akhtar, project manager at the group, said "Both of these projects are close to our organisations ethos and issues we are currently tackling at the community level. This will allow us to involve staff and learners to participate in the programme sharing their experiences whilst learning from European partners.
